

FL-TERT State Regional Coordinator

Position Responsibility: Act as a liaison to the TERT from the Requesting PSAP in their Region. The TERT Regional Coordinator is the single point of contact between the requesting PSAP and deployed team. Will assist the TERT State Coordinator for managing the TERT program and coordinating TERT deployments. The Standard for Telecommunicator Emergency Response Taskforce (TERT) Deployment. TERT Standard Plan is used as the method to mobilize and deploy TERT Teams resources.

Actions:

Appointed by the FL APCO Disaster Committee Chair in conjunction with the Florida Chapter Board.

Shall be responsible for tracking all available TERT members in their Region

Shall be responsible for providing TERT training information to the regional PSAPS

Shall be responsible for assuring the TERT has appropriate access and support to fulfill assigned duties

The Regional Liaison will ensure that qualified TERT Members have submitted the appropriate documentation to be a TERT member

Will coordinate with and if needed be assigned as a member of the Regional TERT Management Team.

Shall be familiar with the FL-TERT Standards standardized forms for ordering resources into the affected areas.

Must comply with the APCO/NENA TERT Standards deployment requirements as defined by the TERT typing document.

The following training is also recommended;

Incident Management System – ICS 100-200-700-800 (Tert Team leaders)

Knowledge of an Integrated Emergency Management System

Shall identify at least one alternate for the region to assist them-**prefer from another agency distance away in same Region**

Serves as a member of the APCO FL- Disaster Committee Group

Interacts with various county emergency operation centers in their region.

Is familiar with and meets at least 2 times per year with the FL Chapter Regional TERT coordinator(s).

Monitors incident operations to identify a need for a TERT deployment

Predetermines, personnel, etc. that are available for response from within the region.

Communicates with the FL-TERTstate coordinator.

Responsible for training of staff, functional leaders, and alternates.

Utilizes Incident Management System as the management structure and establishes the components of it as needed in support of the region's activities.

Prepares a TERT Team available for rapid mobilization within 3 hours of a request.

May serve as a liaison between Unified Command agencies within their region during activation.
